AUTO RUNS OVER MAN

The Choctaw Herald October 23, 1919 - transcribed by Ron Henson

Sunday afternoon about 6 o'clock a service car driven by a woman, whose name we could not learn, ran over Joe Laney, at the corner of Jackson & Broadway. The car knocked him down and dragged him some distance, while he was holding on to the fender. His hold broke and he fell under the car, which ran over him and seriously injured him, it is reported.

The corner of Broadway & Jackson is dangerous and there should be a traffic cop there, especially on Saturdays and Sundays.
