

CHARGED WITH PANDERING
J.H. Brader and Wiley Hildreth Under Serious Charge

The Hugo Daily Husonian June 15, 1915 - transcribed by Ron Henson

Monday evening Sheriff Loftin and Deputy Fitzgerald raided the M.W.A. rooming house and the Brader hotel. At the M.W.A. they arrested Wiley Hildreth, proprietor, and two girls, one not over fourteen years of age it is thought. C.W. Wildey, a porter was taken in charge.

At the Brader the officers' arrested J.H. Brader the owner and A. Hodges. Three girls were found there and they were also arrested. The county attorney filed charegs [sic] against Mr. Brader and Hildreth on the charge of pandering which is a felony in Olahoma [sic]. The penalty for one found guilty of pandering is from two to twenty years in the penitentiary. The examining trial will come up tomorrow morning at nine o'clock before Judge Oakes in the court house in the court room of Judge Glenn.
