Frisco Changes Hugo Water Port to Sawyer

The Frisco railroad had ordered station of Roby, Hugo's famous watering resort and sea hauling landing port changed to comply with the government's post office name of Sawyer. Sawyer is also listed as Gilbert on certain old plats.

This order is in line with a general policy recently adopted by the road to have all of its stations conform to the post office names.
