

SOPER FIRE WORK OF INCENDIARIES

Dany Moore, a young man who has been working for W.W. Adams the past four years but lately employed by Houston Dumas, is alleged to have confessed to setting fire to the building which contained the corn and cotton seed which caused such a disastrous fire last Friday morning. It is further alleged that he implicates Houston Dumas as an accomplice. Both he and young Dumas are now lodged in the county jail, awaiting a preliminary trial. Dewey Roberson is also in jail, charged with obtaining money under false pretense in regard to the cotton seed.
