

FRY SAW MILL BURNED TUESDAY MORNING

The Soper Democrat November 10, 1927 - transcribed by Ron Henson

The saw mill belonging to Rufe Fry, about 7 miles northwest of Soper was burned Tuesday morning. The mill, together with many thousands of feet of lumber were a total loss, with no insurance. The fire was discovered about 3 o'clock but was beyond control. The loss is estimated at about \$12,000[?].

Mr. Fry states that another mill has been bought and that it will be installed in the same location and ready for work next week.
