ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT AND INCORPORATION

Of The Democrat Printing Co

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Corporators hereinafter named have this day, and by these presents, formed a corporation under and in pursuance of an Act of Congress, approved February 18th, 1901, entitled "An Act to put in force in the Indian Territory certain provisions of the Laws of Arkansas relating to Corporations, and to make said provisions applicable to said Territory," which said Act provides for incorporations for manufacturing and other lawful business purposes in the Indian Territory, and in evidence thereof do hereby execute the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of said Corporation shall be The Democrat Printing Co

SECOND: The Corporators are Chas J Parker, Hugh Davis, Alexander McDonald, Chas W Woher and J M Bellings

THIRD: The place of business is to be located at Hugo, Indian Territory and its office for transaction of business shall be in Hugo, Indian Territory or at such other place as the Board of Directors may select.

FOURTH: The general nature of the business proposed to be transacted by this Corporation is to be a general publishing and printing business, and dealing in stationery and office supplies

FIFTH: The amount of capital stock of said Corporation shall be Five Thousand Dollars; of which Twenty-five hundred Dollars has been subscribed by the Corporators aforesaid, and the residue thereof may be issued and disposed of as the Board of Directors may from time to time order and direct.

SIXTH: The capital stock shall be divided into two hundred shares of the value of \$25.00 each.

SEVENTH: The affairs and business of the Corporation shall be conducted and controlled by a Board of Directors, consisting of five members, all of whom shall be stockholders of the Corporation. Said Board of Directors shall elect one of its members as President, and one of its members as Vice-President, and shall also elect a Secretary and Treasurer.

EIGHTH: The first election of Directors shall be held immediately after the organization of the Corporation, and said Directors shall serve for one year and until their successors are elected.

NINTH: The Board of Directors are empowered to ordain and establish all by-laws and regulations necessary to the management and business of said Corporation, and alter and repeal same at pleasure.

TENTH: The first meeting of said Corporators for organization shall be held in Hugo, Indian Territory at the office of Alexander McDonald at 7:30 o'clock PM on the 10th day of May 1906. The subscribers hereto hereby waive notice of said meeting.

WHEREAS, at the time and place above set out, a meeting of the subscribers aforesaid was held to organize said Corporation and elect *five* Directors; and,

WHEREAS, At said meeting the following named persons were elected Directors, to-wit:
Chas J Parker, Hugh Davis, Alexander McDonald, Chas H Wohrer and J M Bellings

WHEREAS, At a meeting of the said Board of Directors *Chas J Parker* and *Alexander McDonald* was elected Vice-President, and *J M Bellings* was elected Secretary, and *Chas H Wohrer* was elected Treasurer. and, was elected President.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said *Chas J Parker, Hugh Davis, Alexander McDonald, Chas H Wohrer and J M Bellings* as President, and the said

as Directors, do, in pursuance of law, issue this, their Certificate, verified by their oaths, and do hereby certify as follows:

FIRST: Said Corporation is formed for the purpose of *to do a general publishing and printing business and dealing in stationery and office supplies*

SECOND: Its capital stock is *Five Thousand* Dollars, divided into shares of \$25.00 each.

THIRD: *Twelve Hundred and fifty* Dollars of said capital stock have been actually paid in by the subscribers hereto.
