STORM AT CODY KILLED TWO

The Choctaw Herald October 9, 1919 - transcribed by Ron Henson

It was learned in the city at three o'clock that the storm which demolished Arthur City struck Cody, ten miles northeast of Hugo and did great damage.

Asa Hatcher and his mother were killed when their house blew down on them. Mrs. Asa Hatcher and two children were seriously hurt.

Our informant came to the city for coffins for the dead but stated he did not go to the vicinity of the storm and did not know just what other damage was done, and bereaved these two were the only ones killed.
