STABBED NEGRO SEVEN TIMES

Yesterday morning in Ft. Towson Clemm Epps, negro, was stabbed seven times with a knife by J.W. Jackson also a negro. Not satisfied with merely stabbing his victim Jackson afterward picked up a two by four scantling and struck Epps on the leg above the knee, breaking the limb. Epps is now lying in a serious condition in Ft. Towson. Jackson was placed under arrest and brought to Hugo where he was lodged in jail with a charge of assault with attempt to kill filed against him.
