

ROBERT COSAD FOUND UNCONSCIOUS IN HIS ROOM AT GRANT FRIDAY MORNING

Right Side is Paralyzed and Physicians Say Merchant is in Dangerous
Condition

Robert S. Cosad, Grant merchant and one of the most widely known citizens of Southeastern Oklahoma, was found in his rooms over the store at Grant Friday morning paralyzed.

Mr. Cosad had retired at about the usual time Thursday evening and was found in his bed this morning with his entire right side paralyzed and he has been unconscious since being found Friday morning and reported at noon that the patient was in a very dangerous condition.

Mr. Cosad had not been feeling well for several days but had no premonition of any serious illness. Two years ago he had a sever attack of pneumonia but since that time had been in ordinary health.

Perhaps no citizen of Choctaw county is more widely known and liked than "Bob" Cosad. Everybody who has been in the county any length of time knows him and to know him is to be his friend.
